We faced some adversity during our season losing the reigning conference player of the year for the season after just five games. We stayed together, made strides & would finish with an outstanding 21-6 record. We lost a heartbreaker in extra innings in the District final to the eventual State Runner up, Grove City. Over the last four years, Gales Baseball has went 92-26 winning four straight OCC titles and three of four District titles. As a whole, the program consists of around 50 families, varying each year to some degree. The program's primary focus is giving 100% in each aspect of life.
